Please be advised that Manitoba Health has recently the policy regarding regarding food handler training courses. We are now recognizing the TrainCan certificate as equivalent to the Manitoba Health Food Handler Training Certificate. If students pass the TrainCan exam and receive the TrainCan certificate, there is no need for them to pay for or obtain the Manitoba Health certificate. The TrainCan certificate meets the requirements of the City of Winnipeg's Food Service Establishment Bylaw No. 5160/89.
